## **CONSTRUCTION OF PORTABLE YARDS**

From 1st January 2010, a new rule came into effect concerning the construction of stables & yards at events run under EA rules.

Anyone wishing to construct stables or yards at EA events must note: "Stabling & yards should be of solid construction. From 01 January 2010, the use of electrified tape, strings, ropes or chains, will not be permitted at EA Events."

## **CAMPING & PARKING**

We ask that you be mindful of space restrictions & keep portable yards (eg 3m x 3m per horse) & camping area to a minimum . If you don't observe this courtesy you may be required move your yard or camp areas accordingly. Please be considerate to other competitors & heed the direction of Show Officials in relation to parking, camping & horse yards.

### **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

**On paying gate fees you will be issued with a ticket which verifies that you have paid. You will be required to produce this ticket when entering horse classes. If you enter the ground when the gate is not staffed, gate fees will be payable at the time of making entries.**

#### **SHOWJUMPING**

Every entry must be paid for in full prior to competing.

Showjumping event entries must be made at the ring Secretaries office 15 minutes before the commencement of event.

EFA rules apply. Registration certificate numbers must be produced on entering where required.

Prizemoney to be collected from the Secretaries office & performance cards must be produced at this point.

#### **RINGS ONE & TWO**

Ring events will be by means of \$3 tickets that may be purchased at the ring Secretaries caravan.

Competitors may compete in all rings. If they gain first (1st) place, Champion or Reserve Champion they cannot compete in the same event in another ring.

**Due to an extended & very full program competitors may be required to choose between events.**

Reserve Champions – When a champion ribbon has been awarded the exhibit that gained second place to the champion in the preceding individual class shall then be eligible to come forward to compete for reserve champion together with the other class winners.

In events for teams a separate entry is required for each hack or rider.

Novice events are open to any horse that has not won first place in a novice or open hack event at any Royal, Agricultural show or similar event.

Every animal must be under thorough control. Stallions must have a bit & cannot compete in miscellaneous events except in specified classes. Handlers/rider must be 17 years old and over. Please note there are no stallion boxes available for horse accommodation.

No competitor or other person is permitted to enter the ring and query the judge. All enquiries must be directed to the relevant steward.

In classes where horses are required to be registered with the relative breed or association, competitors must produce registration papers on entry into ring to be eligible for judging.

A fee of \$50 must be lodged with disputes in writing 30 minutes after completion of judging. The fee may be forfeited if the committee considers the protest frivolous.

Unless specified prizemoney is:- 1st - \$10, 2nd - \$7, Led Champion - \$15, Ridden Champion - \$25, Reserve Champion - ribbon only.

Due to no horse measuring stand, the respective judge will have final say on what height class an exhibit is eligible to compete in.

Exhibits which compete in Show Hunter classes are not able to compete in open or novice hack classes but they may compete in any relevant breed classes.

All prizemoney must be collected on the day.

The Dalgety Show Society Inc. reserves the right to refuse any nomination or alter program.

# THE NIMMITY BELL SHOWJUMPING POINTSCORE

***Established in 1981***

The "Nimity Bell" showjumping pointscore is a competition run over 4 shows – Nimmitabel, Delegate, Dalgety and Bombala. The "Nimity Bell" trophy is to be awarded to the horse with the highest pointscore in open competition over 4 shows. This will be awarded at the completion of EA events at the Bombala Show.

1. Only horses registered with the EA of NSW are eligible for the pointscore. Horses can only score in EA events that potentially count for grading, i.e. the event is 1.05 m or higher, the event has a total prize pool worth \$100 or more, the event is officiated by an EA accredited Judge and Course Designer. All entrants in these events will be eligible for the "Nimity Bell Pointscore" regardless of the total amount of entries in one class.
2. A horse can only score once at each show. This score will be the horse's best top 5 placing from that show. If a horse fails to place in an event, it will score zero for that show. The points will be awarded as follows:  
1st = 5 points, 2nd = 4 points, 3rd = 3 points, 4th = 2 points,  
5th = 1 point, no placing yet eligible = 0 points.
3. Horses must compete at all 4 shows to be eligible for the "Nimity Bell Pointscore". The only exception will be if an official vet certificate is presented to the official scorer indicating the horse's inability to compete at one of the 4 shows.
4. The official point scorer is responsible for collecting results from the official judge of each show and then allocating points according to the rules above. Any disputes regarding the "Nimity Bell Pointscore" must be directed to the official pointscorer to be dealt with. All events are EA events and will be run in accordance to EA rules.
5. EA summer dress standards apply for competitors.
6. Overall prizemoney will be awarded to the top 5 placegetters at the completion of EA events at Bombala Show. The prizemoney this year is:  
1st \$425    2nd \$240    3rd \$160    4th \$115    5th \$60.

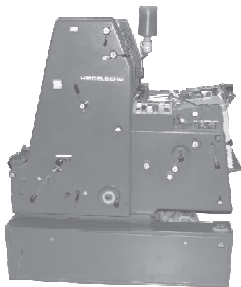
